We currently participate in four recycling programmes air, home and laundry care, biscuit and snack wrappers, printer cartridges and bread bags.

These programmes are run externally and the items collected do vary from time to time.

The air, home and laundry care programme has recently changed

Accepted waste:	Sorry we cannot accept:
Plastic air freshener containers	Aerosols
Plastic air freshener cartridge caps	Glass air fresheners cartridges
Plastic car air fresheners	Transparent plastic bottles and caps
Flexible wipe packaging (for home cleaning products)	Caps from home cleaning and dishwashing products
Flexible laundry washing capsules and pod packaging	Flexible plastic packaging not used for dishwasher tablets as well as washing capsules and pods
Flexible dishwasher tablet packaging	Flexible wipe packaging not used for home cleaning (such as baby and beauty wipes)
Tinted fabric conditioner bottles and caps
