


Route 4 – Circular Route (Warfield Street and Larks Hill)

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Frost Folly Car Park ▶
start and finish



Please take care as this route involves walking along country lanes with few footpaths.

This route includes crossing a narrow footbridge.

Please take care when crossing Harvest Ride and Warfield Road.

Leave the car park by the pedestrian gate at the end of the fence in the east corner. Follow the track to the church. In Church Lane turn right and continue to the bottom of the hill where you will see a footpath signpost just past the big house gates on your left.

Follow the footpath crossing the Cut and exit into a large grass field. Keep on straight ahead through a rambler stile and then a pedestrian gate into Gibbins Lane. At the end of the lane turn left into Warfield Street and take the pavement until you reach a small turning on the right. This is Maize Lane. Approx. 100 yards down Maize Lane is a bridleway on your right. The hedge was planted by parish volunteers and the lane is called Hedge Lane. Follow Hedge Lane until it meets Old Priory Lane. Turn left along Old Priory Lane until you join Harvest Ride.

Cross over, turn right and follow the pavement to the roundabout to Warfield Road. Cross over and enter Larks Hill. Follow any of the paths to the bottom right-hand corner of this large open space.

Listen for the larks and many other species of birds, particularly if you passed the community orchard on the right-hand side as you look down the hill.

At the bottom, exit into Watersplash Lane and cross straight over into Avery Lane. This is one of the old parish roads and is still a byway open to all traffic. Avery Lane will bring you to The Spice lounge (formerly The Three Legged Cross).

Turn right, past the old Warfield Garage, and cross over into the drive of Scotlands Farm. Approx. 20 yards down the drive take the stile on your right, cross the field and then take the path along the edge of the Memorial Ground out into Osborne Lane.

Turn left and follow the lane to the bridge. Don't cross the bridge but take the footpath on your right and follow this along the Cut, keeping left at any turnings until you exit into Church Lane. Turn left to the junction of Osborne Lane, bear right into Westhatch lane and then right again into Wellers Lane and back to the car park.
