

New Warfield Development

Land to the west of Avery Lane (known as area 2) - construction continues on phase 1 of the Berkeley Homes' site, including the building of 87 homes at the south western corner of the site towards Frampton's Bridge roundabout/Jock's Lane Recreation Ground and the new road linking the Quelm Park roundabout to Forest Road. Construction has also started on the first of Warfield's two new primary schools (a two-form entry school, including nursery), with the school expected to open in September 2016. In addition, the planning applications for the Cut Corridor and for 94 homes immediately east of the phase 1 housing site have recently been approved, and two more planning applications – for 40 shared-ownership and 18 private apartments, and for 65 affordable senior living apartments – are currently being considered by Bracknell Forest Council.

Land to the east of Avery Lane and west of Maize Land (known as area 1) - no planning applications are currently being considered for this area.

Land to the east of Maize Lane (known as area 3) - discussions are currently taking place regarding the development of a masterplan for this area.

Cabbage Hill – a planning application for this site of Suitable Alternative Natural Green Space (SANG) has recently been approved.

Warfield Neighbourhood Plan Update

At the end of July, the Warfield Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group presented all work to date to an independent Planning Consultant. After a thorough review of the draft policies, all evidence collected, existing strategies and Borough Plans, a report was issued with recommendations on how to progress the Warfield Plan to submission status. The Steering Group have taken these recommendations and are now working with the Planning Consultant with an aim to produce a draft Neighbourhood Plan document very early next year. The Plan would then go through a series of consultation rounds, including consultation with residents who will be able to give feedback on the document before it goes for formal approval.
