

New Warfield Development

Development work in Warfield continues apace. For new residents to the area, the developments outlined are part of the Warfield Strategic Development Area (SDA) which was identified for new housing by Bracknell Forest Council in 2008. The site allocation allowed for a mix of uses including 2,200 homes, a neighbourhood centre and two new primary schools.

Berkeley Homes are continuing work at Woodhurst Park (area 2) and we have seen completion of the senior living dwellings and other dwellings along Sopwith Road. We expect Sopwith Road to be connected to the new Forest Road roundabout shortly. Berkeley Homes are currently preparing planning applications for the phase 6 and 7, which border the Cabbage Hill SANG to the north and Harvest Ride to the south.

Work will be commencing shortly on the Area 1 site at Newell Green and bordering Watersplash Lane. This site will be delivering 211 dwellings. Access for most of these dwellings will be from Sopwith Road.

Many of you will have attended the recent exhibition by Thomas Lawrence, Danescroft and Taylor Wimpey for the development of up to 310 dwellings and a new primary school on land between Old Priory Lane and Maize Lane. Comments provided are now being considered ahead of submission of an outline planning application.

Initial design work on the new Community hub adjacent to Priory Field has now commenced. We hope to share the initial proposals for the community centre with you soon.

World War 1 Commemoration

As part of the national commemoration marking the end of World War 1, we will be lighting a beacon at Cabbage Hill car park on Forest Road on Sunday 11th November at 7pm. You are welcome to join us as we mark this historic event.

Parish Council Grants 2019/20

Warfield Parish Council allocates money each year to be awarded in grants to organisations for projects or events that will be of benefit to the residents of the Parish. Most of the grant funding made by Warfield Parish Council is allowed under Section 137 of the Local Government

Act 1972 which empowers the Parish Council to spend some of its money, subject to limits, on purposes that it considers to be 'in the interests of, and will bring direct benefit to, their area, or any part of it, or all or some of its inhabitants'. Grants under Section 137 are only available to groups or organisations; personal applications for support cannot be considered.
